**GRACE, NOT WORKS**



*Read Ephesians 2:8–9*

**Salvation is:**

- a gift
- given by grace
- received through faith

**Grace means:**

- you don't earn salvation
- you don't fix yourself first
- you don't qualify yourself

**Good works matter —**

**but they come after salvation, not before it.**

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## WHO DO PEOPLE SAY JESUS IS?

**Jesus asked His disciples two questions:**

1. Who do people say I am?

2. Who do **you** say I am?

**Peter answered, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.”**

**This shows us that faith becomes real when Jesus is not just known publicly, but personally.**



***Why do you think Jesus asked this question?***

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**WHO JESUS IS IN SCRIPTURE**



***Read John 1:1-14***

**This passage teaches us that:**

- Jesus existed before creation
- Jesus is the Word of God
- Jesus became human and lived among us

God did not stay distant.

He came close.



**Read Colossians 1:15–17**

These verses tell us that:

- Jesus created all things
- Jesus holds everything together
- Jesus reveals what God is like
